Sivaneer Rampersad, has been accepted into the changemakers collective fellowship at Asia Plateau (MRA Centre), Panchgani commencing on 15th January 2026 and ending on 14th June, 2026.

The Changemakers Collective Fellowship is a five-month residential programme providing participants an opportunity to immerse in Indian culture while developing skills and perspectives to be a values driven changemaker.

Fellows will also participate in specialized training, self-led initiatives and community-building activities that build practical skills and leadership capacity. The programme is part of the broader Changemakers Collective, an initiative focused on nurturing young people in lofC (Initiatives of Change) principles to address global challenges guided by inner wisdom.

Through this programme, fellows will:

- Live and volunteer in a resident community experiencing daily life, festivals and social dynamics in a diverse cultural setting
- Learn about India's religious and regional diversity while building meaningful cross-cultural relationships with people from across India
- Gain clarity on personal values guided by lofC's philosophy
- Understand the role of service in leadership within a community context
- Learn how lofC approaches to social change can inform global solutions

The overall aim of the programme is to prepare fellows to create change in themselves and their communities as well as step up in positions of responsibility and leadership. The total cost of the programme is Rs. 250,000 (~\$2805) of which the cost is heavily subsidized by the centre's own fundraising efforts leaving a minimum cost of Rs. 45,000 (~\$505) for each fellow to raise which helps to deepen their commitment and ownership of the journey. These costs cover all accommodation, meals and domestic travel expenses.
