Medical Opinion/ Treatment Plan	As per the available information/shared reports, patient is advised to undergo detailed evaluation which includes, PET CT WHOLE BODY, CT guided FNAC, IGRT to brain then oral targeted therapy per month for 3 months followed by reassessment.
	If patient is affording, then an alternative option is to give immunotherapy per cycle every 21 days with re assessment after 4 cycles.
	*Note: The treatment plan may change after complete evaluation of the patient. Any change of treatment plan will be in the best interest of the patient keeping specific findings in mind. *

### Visa Assistance:

 International Patient Services (IPS) team helps in arranging visa by writing a letter to Indian High Commission in the patient's country. This helps to obtain medical visa not only for patient but also for accompanying attendants.

#### Payment:

- We have a currency exchange counter in the IPS Lounge, west block (basement). The team shall assist you with the same.
- Alternatively, payment can be made either through credit card or cash on arrival or wire transfers.

### Hotel / Service Apartment / Guest House Arrangement:

- The hospital is located in the heart of South Delhi. In case you need assistance in arranging accommodation near hospital as per your preference/budget, IPS team shall help you with it.
- Good accommodation near the hospital costs approx. USD 60- US 80 per night.

### **Other Information**

#### **During Hospitalization:**

- Guest Relations Executive will be your Single Point of contact (SPOC) throughout the entire stay in the hospital for all non-medical assistance like registration, admission, discharge formalities, sim card, hotel/guesthouse accommodation etc.
- Patient should carry a photocopy of their passport as a proof of identity at the time of treatment to Max Hospital, Saket.

### **Currency Declaration:**

- If you are carrying currency worth 5000 USD or more, you must declare this at the point of entry in India and obtain a certificate for the same.
- If you have not made this declaration, the hospital can only accept USD 5000 in cash.

Please be informed that due to the Covid-19 pandemic, there will some additional charges for the PPE kits used for the safety of the patient and their care provider during the treatment. The charges of PPE Kits used will be collected from you as per actual usage.
